p. 11, Certification, para. 3	Amended text	The hard copy you send in to the PME must be the same version they have <b>uploaded</b> on-line and carry the <b>Project Reference</b> that they will allocate as part of the submitting and checking stages.		
p.12, Cloning an Application, para. 1	Amended text	As a general rule cloning an application is not encouraged and should only be used if requested by the PME.		
p.12, Cloning an Application, para. 2 (previous)	Deleted text	The clone facility makes this easy to do and saves a lot of re-typing. For example this is particularly useful where one project requires a separate application for the Eligible and Transition areas.		
p.12, Cloning an Application, para. 2	Amended text	If the revision to your application requires a change to any items entered into the original CREATE tab (Programme, Priority and Measure) a new application is required and the clone facility is not suitable.
